Confidentiality...

We take your right to confidentiality seriously. We will only share information about you outside of Klinik if we have your permission **except** in the following situations:

Child Welfare

The law requires all citizens to report child abuse and neglect. If we believe that a child is at risk, we will ask the appropriate agency for help.

Threats of Harm

If we believe that you or someone else may suffer serious harm or death, we will do what is necessary for safety. We may need to ask for help from emergency services and/or other professionals.

Justice System

In rare instances, the court or police may ask to see client records.

We will always try to tell you about any actions we may need to take to keep everyone safe.
